- 1. <u>Court Hearing:</u> The Blooming Dreams' Superior Court Default Appeal Hearing, regarding lake-rights, will be Tuesday, May 21, at 9:30 AM in Wilkes Barre. Hopefully BML will prevail.
- 2. <u>Dam Remediation:</u> As disclosed at the March Association General Meeting, it is the hope that the entire cost (\$3.8 million) of the project will be paid by multiple government grants. However, a Special Assessment of all BML owners may be necessary if there is a cost balance.
- 3. **General Manager:** Karen Amici has been selected as the new BML General Manager. The Board wishes to thank Cody Hess for his service to BML.
- 4. **Fishing Derby:** This year's Fishing Derby has been canceled due to several factors including lack of volunteers and the uncertainty with QHV.
- 5. **Boat Trailer Storage:** The trailer storage area has been relocated from the lot on Debbie Drive to the former archery range on Four Seasons Drive.
- 6. **Boat Rental:** Boat rentals have been discontinued due primarily to increased liability as well as the overhead costs making boat rentals a non-viable operation.
- 7. **Code Enforcement:** Code Enforcement is focusing on vehicle stickers and abandoned cars and untidy properties.
