



Strawberry Social


The Strawberry Social has been scheduled for Saturday June 4th. Time is to be announced. More details to follow

TIPS FROM PENN STATE MASTER GARDENERS

HELLO BEECH MOUNTAIN GARDENERS!

We have been on a rollercoaster ride weather- wise this winter. Record highs followed by record lows have kept us guessing about what's next. Even though we have experienced some almost summer-like weather, we can still expect snow and cold weather. So don't start planting yet!

WINTER CHORES

There is still time to tackle some of those winter gardening chores. March is a good time to prune trees and shrubs. Of course avoid pruning those early blooming shrubs like rhododendron or forsythia. If you have knockout roses they should be pruned back after the last hard frost. Knockouts will grow back vigorously in time for blooming.

If you are not sure of what to prune or how to prune, I recommend that you check a comprehensive pruning guide from the University of Minnesota titled "Pruning Trees and Shrubs." It provides detailed information on how, when, and what to prune. You can find it online at;

SPRING INTO GARDENING

Once again Luzerne County Master Gardeners will be pre-



senting their half day seminar series, SPRING INTO GARDENING. The event will be held from 8:30 AM until 1:00 PM on Saturday, April 30th at Penn State Wilkes-Barre Campus in Lehman. This year SIG will offer seven workshops including the keynote presentation by Paul Epson, Star of WNEP's Home and Backyard Program.

Master Gardeners from Luzerne will be offering six other presentation at *SIG* including;

Jumping Worms Roseann Nardone, will be explaining the most recently discovered exotic pest in The United States, Asian Jumping Worms. This significant pest is an earthworm that is destroying soil structure in many parts of Luzerne County including right here in Beech Mountain Lakes.



Veggie Gardening Covid 19 has led many home owners to consider growing some of their own vegetables. Sandy Visintainer, will be offering tips and advice for newcomers and experienced gardeners planning to vegetable garden this year

Native Plants in the Home Garden Marietta Garr will discuss the personal and ecological advantages of using native plants in your garden and landscape.



The Spotted Lanternfly is now established in Luzerne County and a few have been reported in Beech Mountain. David Todd will give an update on the Spotted Lanternfly, how to identify it and what to do

if you find it around your home or backyard.


Guess Who's Coming to Dinner Beech Mountain Lakes' Dave Orbin will discuss dealing with wildlife in your land-scape and garden.
