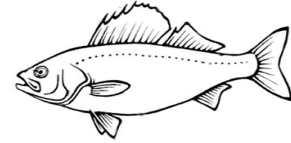




Beech Mountain Lakes



2018 NON-RESIDENT BOAT REGISTRATION RULES & REGULATIONS

Non-Resident Boat Sticker Fee - \$100.00

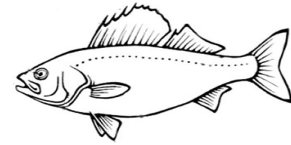
1. Non-Residents who wish to register a boat at Beech Mountain Lakes/ Quail Hollow must come in together with their BML/QH owner/sponsor. The BML/QH owner/sponsor must be in good standing and must have a membership card on file in the Recreation Department. NO EXCEPTIONS.
2. If you are required to register your boat, a copy of the registration must be on file with your application. NO EXCEPTIONS.
3. NO GAS POWERED BOATS are permitted on the lake. NO EXCEPTIONS. If you take your gas motor off your boat, you may register the boat. The working Attendant must physically see your boat for verification.
4. Both the BML/QH owner/sponsor and non-resident registrant must both sign that attached Addendum which will indicate:
 - Both understand that the lake is catch and release for bass and perch.
 - Both understand that BMLA reserves the right to inspect any boat at any time to ensure that all boating/fishing rules and being followed.
 - Both have received a copy of the boating rules and agree to abide by them.

Anyone violating any of the rules regarding boating on the Beech Mountain Lake will face disciplinary action, including but not limited to the revocation of boating rights.

DOES NOT APPLY TO WET SLIP BOATS.
